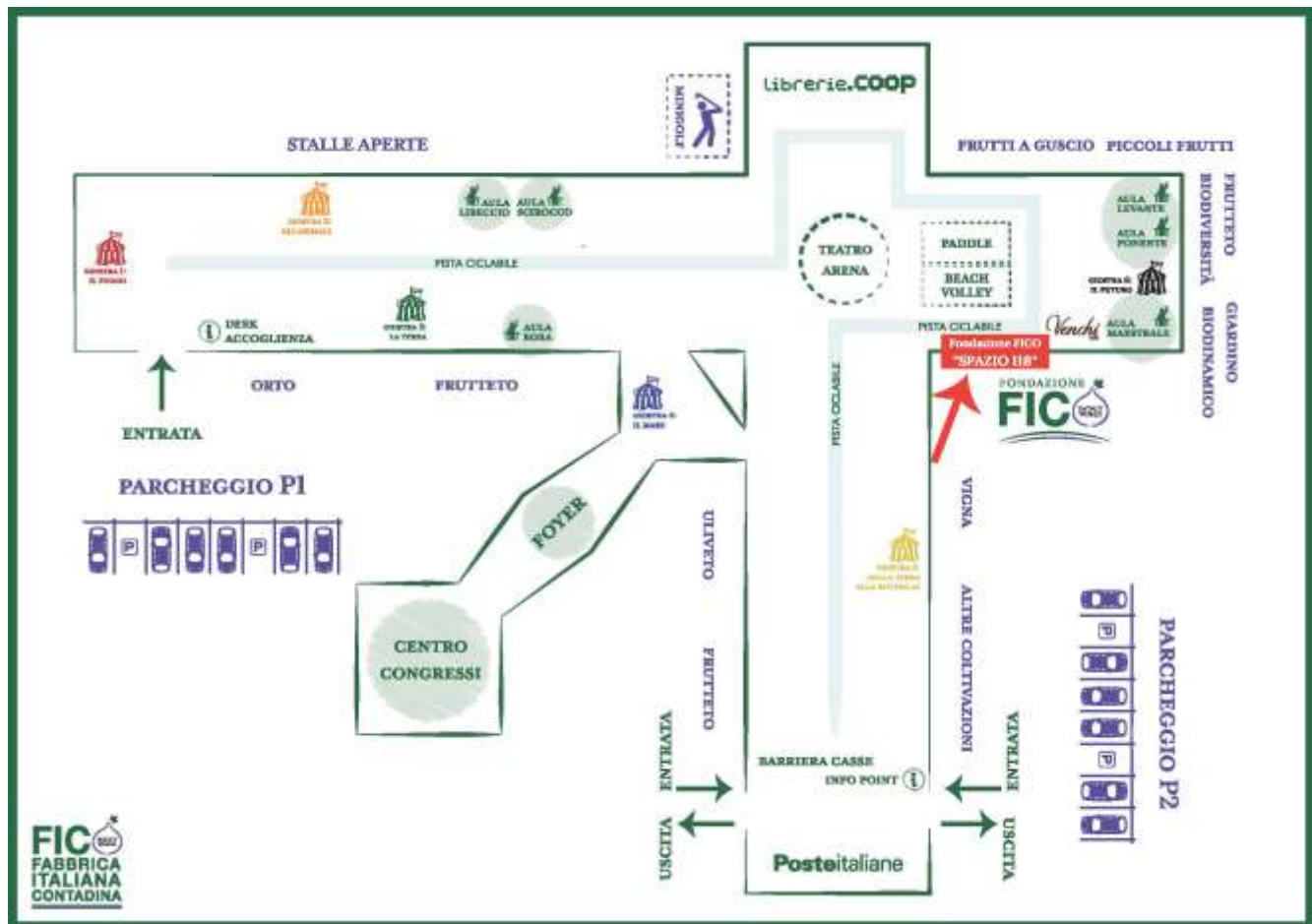


How to get to the meeting from the city center

- By Taxi: from the Bologna city center you can take a taxi from the Righi Taxi stand in Via Indipendenza (in front of the Arena del Sole) at a fixed cost of €20. For more information and for reserve a taxi 0039051372727
- By TPER FICO SHUTTLE: from the train station take the TPER FICO SHUTTLE running every day from 9:30 am, on weekdays Monday to Friday every 30 minutes, Saturdays and holidays every 20 minutes. Single ride fee 5€, same day round trip fee 7€
